

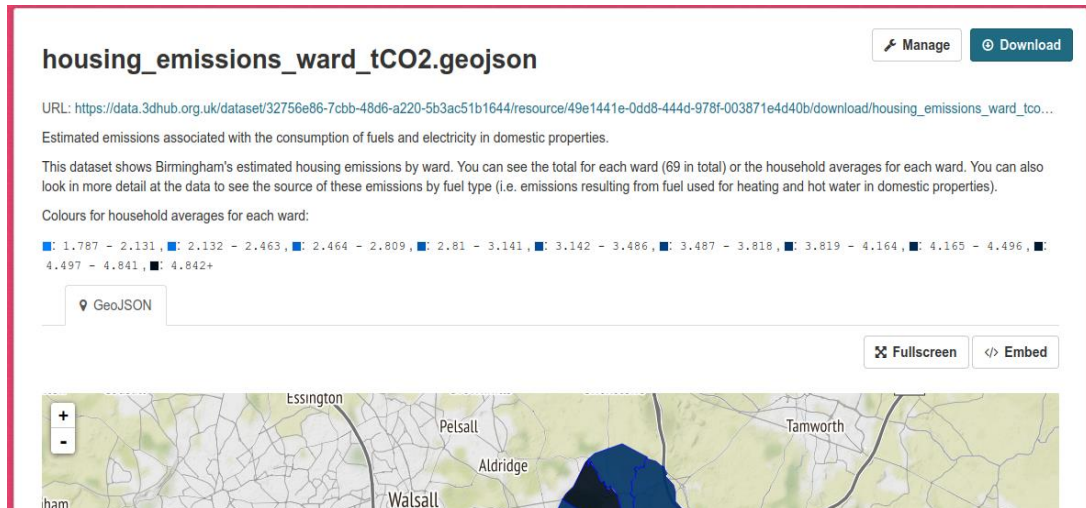

3D data hub - how to embed graphs, maps, or data tables from the hub into your website

This is a guide to embedding graphs, maps, or data tables from the 3D data hub (<https://data.3dhub.org.uk>) into your own website. It must be a website, CMS or blogging platform that supports entering raw HTML.

- **Step 1:** Navigate to the graph you want to embed.
- **Step 2:** Click the 'embed' button. In the screenshot below it is in the bottom-right-hand corner:



- **Step 3:** You should see the following dialog box appear:

You can copy and paste the embed code into a CMS or blog software that supports raw HTML

Here you can choose the width and height of the embedded graph (in pixels). You may also specify percentage values for width.

- **Step 4:** Copy the text beginning with "<iframe" from the "code" box in the dialog above, and add it to your own website. How to do this depends on the details on what tools your website uses.
